

The Third Hangar A New Icon for the Hong Kong International Airport

The Hong Kong Business Aviation Centre (HKBAC) proudly reveals its new state-of-the-art hangar facility that will become the next new icon for the Hong Kong International Airport. The new third hangar complements superbly the existing two hangars in providing ample hangar spaces to meet the fast-paced development of business aviation in the region as well as the growing demand for aircraft hangarage in Hong Kong.



With a total hangar floor area of over 43,000 square feet, it is the biggest among the three. It is specially designed to accommodate six to eight aircraft of different sizes or a maximum of six ultra-long-range jets. With the new hangar in operation, the total hangarage capacity of HKBAC rises to 18. HKBAC, as a leading Fixed-Base Operator (FBO) in Asia, continues to give flyers new premium services via world-class hangar facilities as well as leading-edge technologies.

Equipped with the vast knowledge and experience in building and managing hangars in the past, the third hangar was perfectly designed and built to reflect the strengths and the internationally highly acclaimed status of HKBAC. Apart from having a larger hangar floor space, office and workshop spaces of over 22,000 square feet are also available to provide a bountiful amount of airside work space to offer flexibility and convenience to the business jet operators.



As part of HKBAC's commitment and operating principle on striving for continuous improvements, new features have been introduced in this facility -- such as the presence of roller shutters inside the workshops to allow easy and direct access to and from the hangar, installation of triple-bank louvers to enhance on weather proofing while maintaining sufficient airflow and the use of energy saving high bay induction lamps. In short, the third hangar is simply the finest and the most modern business aviation facility in Hong Kong which is also regarded as the best of its kind within the region.



HKBAC has been reaching new heights. 2011 was a record-breaking year for the company where over 7,000 aircraft movements were recorded. More recently, Aviation International News has ranked HKBAC second in the league of Best International FBOs for markets outside of the Americas for five years in a row and the Professional Pilot Magazine has once again named HKBAC the best FBO in Asia for the fifth consecutive year. With a combined total of over 105,000 square feet of hangar floor area, HKBAC is well-positioned to embrace the challenges ahead, to continue offering services that reflects Asian hospitality at its best and its can-do spirit of Hong Kong and to contribute to the development of business aviation industry both here in Hong Kong and in Asia while reinforcing our position as a premier gateway for entrepreneurs and executives doing business in China.
