Hong Kong's first-ever homebuilt aircraft to navigate the globe

(28th August 2016, Hong Kong) B-KOO Inspiration, Hong Kong's first-ever homebuilt aircraft took off today from the Hong Kong International Airport for a 3-month journey of a total of 55,000 km across 50 airports in 25 countries.
