ALEXANDRIA VA—March 30, 2012. Subscribers to *Professional Pilot* magazine returned 4504 forms in the 39th annual PRASE (Preferences Regarding Aviation Services and Equipment) Survey. Judges were 7 corporate pilots who tallied results. Rankings follow.

This year's PRASE Survey attracted a significantly greater number of returns 4504—an increase of 3073 over the total of 1431 forms received in 2011.

Pro Pilot subscribers scored FBO selections from 1 (poor) to 10 (excellent) in 6 categories—Line Team, Customer Service Representatives (CSRs), Facility, Amenities, Promptness & Efficiency, and Value for Price.

45 votes needed to rank in Top US FBOs

A minimum of 45 votes from PP subscribers was the threshold for ranking in the Top US FBOs. For 2012 the total number of ranked US FBOs was 35.

Best Independent FBO Pentastar Aviation PTK Pontiac MI

Most Improved FBO Global Select SGR Houston TX

This award is given to the FBO which made the largest gain in ranking position compared with the previous year. Global Select didn't rank in the top 35 last year but moved into 2nd place this year—hence it advanced by at least 34 positions to win Most Improved US FBO for 2012.

Best Small FBO Chain (3–10) Wilson Air Center (4 bases—CLT, MEM, HOU, CHA)

Best Large FBO Chain (11+) Million Air (26 bases)

In the *Pro Pilot* PRASE Survey the definition of a small chain is 3–10 bases. A large FBO chain contains 11 or more. Those FBOs with only 2 locations are considered as 2 independents. FBO groups classified as networks are not considered FBO chains. PRASE judges established these definitions in 2011.

International

In addition to US FBOs, the PRASE Survey determines the best international FBOs/Handlers within the following areas—Canada, Mexico, Caribbean, Latin America, Europe, Middle East & Africa, and Asia.

PRASE valid voting process

Pro Pilot uses a 4-step process to ensure accurate and valid results.

- 1 Ballots are sent to subscribers in 3 waves—1st in the Nov 2011 issue of *Pro Pilot*, a 2nd group was sent with the Dec 2011 issue, and finally a 3rd mailed separately from the magazine in Jan 2012. Each ballot is sent to subscribers to return the completed ballot to *Professional Pilot* in Alexandria VA. The cutoff date for the 2012 PRASE Survey was Mar 7, 2012. Only original ballots were accepted and no more than 1 ballot per participant. Voting is restricted to qualified *Pro Pilot* subscribers. Organizations or individuals are not permitted to submit ballots or scores in categories where they compete. Public relations, marketing and advertising personnel are ineligible. To ensure proper accreditation is given, ballots are always checked thoroughly to ensure all information listed is current and correct and to confirm FBOs whose names have changed because of mergers or acquisitions. The 2012 PRASE Survey received a total of 4504 ballots. Of those 3475 met the *Pro Pilot* acceptance criteria. A total of 1029 were disqualified due to inconsistencies, errors, duplications or lateness.
- **2** Qualified ballots are shipped to ABCO Data Systems of Vienna VA, a bonded data processing house, to transfer the data from the original forms to an electronic database.
- **3** Database information is sent to Conklin & de Decker of Arlington TX to be analyzed and tabulated as a preliminary step to determine winners and rankings.
- **4** Ballots and scoring were provided to the 7 judges serving on site in Alexandria VA.

Recognition awards

In addition to the ground services scoring for *Pro Pilot's* PRASE Survey, the magazine presents awards each year to companies and individuals recognized for their aerospace achievements. This year there were 2.

- John Deere received the *Professional Pilot* Flight Department of the Year 2011 Award with the honor accepted by Dir of Global Av Services Larrie Dahl.
- FlightSafety International received the 1st *Professional Pilot* SAFE (Safe Aircraft Flying Education) Award for its dedication and commitment to improving aviation safety. Accepting the award plaque was Bruce Whitman, president and CEO of FlightSafety Intl.
